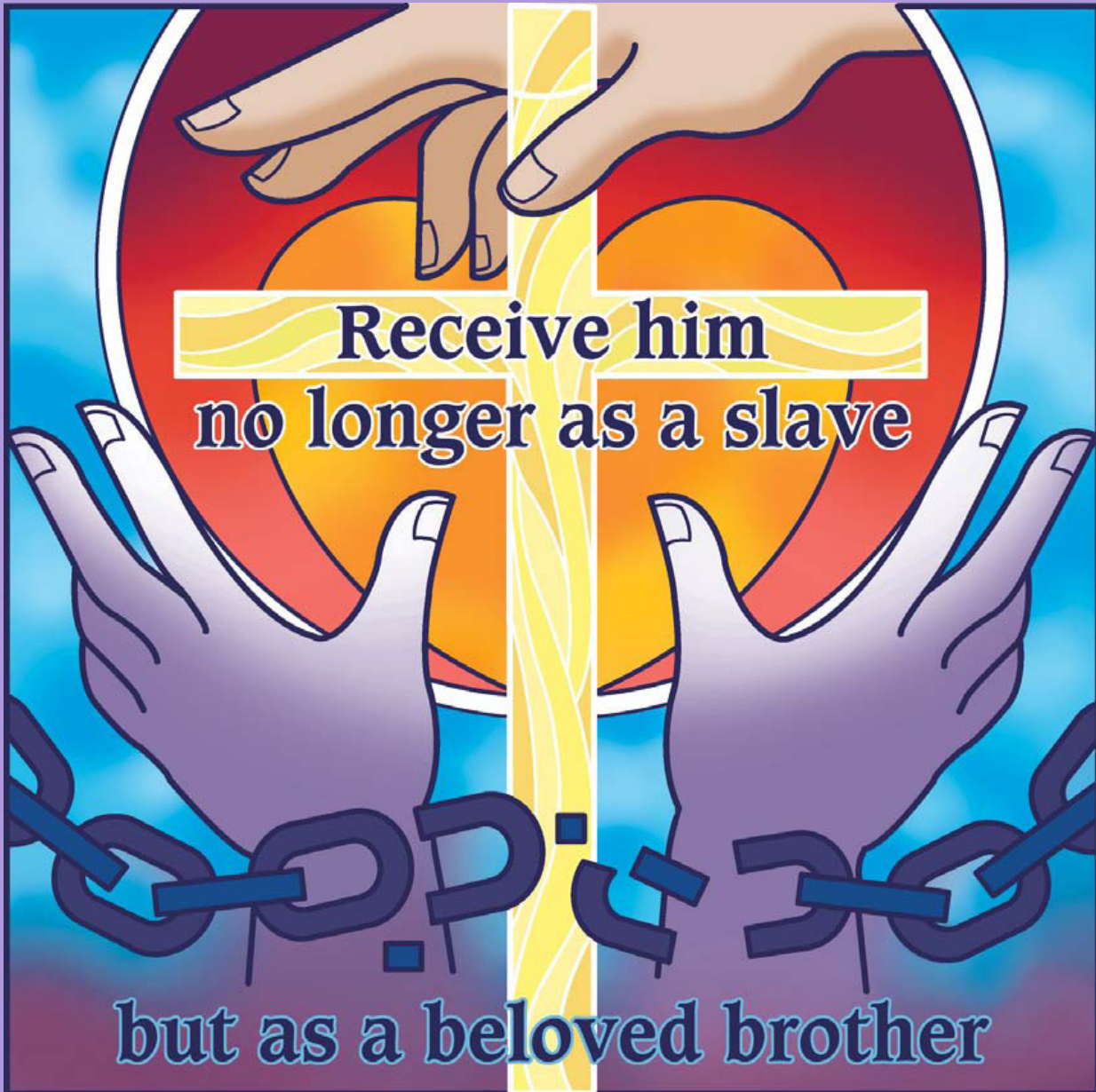

Praying With Your Children

Making an effort to pray daily is an important part of faith formation for children. They follow our example, whether it is morning/evening prayers or mealtime prayers. When we teach our children to pray while still children, it may instill a lifelong healthy habit. Beginning around age two, toddlers can imitate their parents and older siblings during prayer time. The simple gesture of folding their hands is a sweet start to a fruitful prayer life. Prayer at home is a comforting experience, but how can we teach our children to pray anywhere, at any time?

If you do not already pray with your children, begin slowly. You do not want to force them into praying, lest it become an unpleasant chore. Begin with the mealtime prayer, and say it at each meal until it becomes habit. Younger children may be more open to this practice, but teenagers may not be as enthusiastic. Do not try to push them too hard to participate right away. Simply being quiet during this time is a way to show respect for the moment. Keep showing them that this is a new habit that will be taking place several times a day. By observing parents during prayer time, the child will realize that this is not a passing fad that Mom and Dad will eventually forget.

Finally, pray for one another. Ask God to open the hearts of your children. We are not perfect parents. That is not what children need. They need imperfect parents, to allow them to be imperfect. This is the only way to Christ, by surrendering all to Him. We all need help in this area, for pride creeps into all of our hearts every day. Do not be afraid to ask God for help in front of your children. This will give them the confidence to do the same.

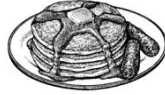

Stewardship Enrollment

Over the past several weeks in the bulletin we have written about Stewardship. At our Enrollment Weekend on September 24—25, there will be 15 Reaching Out Ministries represented at tables at the rear of the church. Here is a description of 5 of those ministries.

SAINT AGNES' REACHING OUT MINISTRIES

BLOOD DRIVE

Is held once a year on Good Friday. It provides parishioners an opportunity to donate blood for those in need in the Bay Area. Opportunities for volunteers are: signing up potential donors and assisting day of the Blood Drive with various duties such as set-up, check-in, etc. (Seasonal)

CARING HANDS

Is coordinated through John Muir Health (925-952-2999). This group helps people over 60 who may be frail, isolated or disabled. By providing free non-medical assistance, seniors are able to stay in their homes and remain independent as long as safely possible. Volunteers provide friendly visits, transportation and escort to medical appointments, help with shopping, etc. Not to be confused with St. Agnes' Helping Hands. (Varying levels of commitment)

FAITH IN ACTION

Helps to find solutions to the biggest problems, such as housing, affecting persons in our deanery; it brings together people, organizations, and communities so that every person of race, gender, or origin can live with dignity and opportunity. (Monthly evening meetings and perhaps follow-up)

GIVING TREE

Provides gifts at Christmas time to vetted community agencies, St. Agnes School and Parish. Volunteers help organize 'stars', set up and monitor trees and help in the distribution of gifts. (Seasonal)

HELPING HANDS

Serves the church community by providing meals in times of need such as funeral receptions, illness, or births. Volunteers provide hospitality for the Mass of Remembrance in November, and donate all the pumpkin pies for the St. Mary's dinner. Not to be confused with 'Caring Hands'. (Varying levels of commitment, day or evening)
